Modern Dallas—An Introduction to Multi-Family Residential Design: W. Dwayne Jones, Preservation Dallas

This class will explore the origins of multi-family housing in the city with special attention on the emergence of this building type nationally. We will look at some new examples of multi-family residences, as well as recent preservation projects.

Preservation of England's Country Houses: Katherine Seale, Preservation Dallas

Thursday, August 18; 6–8 p.m.

England's country house estates are known throughout Britain as the nation's crown jewels, but this was not always so. Following World War I, the great estates fell into disrepair and were cast aside as "white elephants." Today, due in large part to the estate tax incentives and strict land-use laws, many of these estates remain intact, restored and open to the public. Katherine's talk and photomontage will focus on English preservationists' great success in preserving these properties and what we can learn from their efforts.
