



Preservation Dallas 2010 Historic Achievement Awards Nomination

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: 4 p.m., Friday, March 12, 2010

Preservation Dallas' annual Achievement Awards recognizes outstanding projects involving the preservation, rehabilitation, and enhancement of Dallas' historic buildings and neighborhoods. An awards ceremony will be held on the evening of Friday, May 21st.

AWARD CATEGORIES:

- Rehabilitation or Adaptive Use of a residential historic building.
- Rehabilitation or Adaptive Use of a commercial, institutional, or mixed-use building.
- Rehabilitation of a Historic Landscape, Park or other Historic Resource.
- New Construction/Infill in a historic neighborhood. This can include an addition directly attached to a building, or an entirely new building (in-fill) which enhances the historic nature of the original building or streetscape or urban environ.
- GREEN projects that appropriately integrates new technologies and materials to improve the efficiency of the property while maintaining its historic character.

APPLICABLE PROJECTS:

The 2010 Preservation Achievement Awards will be considered for projects completed after January 1, 2008 and located within the City of Dallas or its immediate vicinity. A project can be nominated either by the property owner or by another individual or group, such as a neighborhood organization, building contractor, or architect.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES:

Nominations must be submitted using Preservation Dallas nomination form (see following page). The form should include a project summary and photographs. If you are nominating more than one project, please submit each entry separately.

Please ensure that the following is included in your submission:

- All materials must be clearly identified with the name/address of the nominated project.
- Appropriate credit must be given to project participants.
- Photographs: Submit ten to no more than twenty-four photos of the property. High resolution (minimum of 400 dpi), quality digital photos (jpegs) will be accepted. Please include exterior and interior shots focusing on the historic character of the property. All images should be labeled (i.e., front entry, east side of building, main stairwell, etc) and include a credit line for publication. Before and after shots of the project are strongly encouraged. All images should be in focus with proper exposure.
- All materials must be submitted in a pocket-style folder that contains hard copies and a CD with electronic copies of the materials on a Windows-compatible CD. Materials that were not created electronically should be scanned and copied onto the CD.

SUBMISSION:

Please submit your nomination to Preservation Dallas, Attention: Sara Junkin, 2922 Swiss Avenue, Dallas, Texas 75204. **All submissions must arrive by Friday, March 12th at 4 pm.** All submissions become the property of the Preservation Dallas and will not be returned. The nominator grants permission for materials to be used by Preservation Dallas for presentation and publicity purposes.
